

## Greeting/Expectations

1. The exhibition „Im Verhältnis“ is on display at the Rosa-Luxemburg-Stiftung, located at Straße der Pariser Kommune 8A in the district Friedrichshain-Kreuzberg, Berlin. The Foundation is a multifunctional and newly constructed building, situated on the site of the former postal station, which now serves as an event venue.
2. From the street, a roughly paved sidewalk must first be negotiated. From there a tarred path leads directly to the main entrance. Thus enables barrier-free access to the building.
3. The main entrance to the Rosa-Luxemburg-Stiftung consists of two double-glass doors and a glass revolving door. The right door opens automatically to the outside by using a pressure switch.
4. As soon as you enter through the main entrance, you will find yourself in the forum, where the reception desk is located on the left side. You can find a walking stick holder at the reception desk. The reception desk is not wheelchair-friendly, as it is not lifted.
5. The exhibition is shown in the forum, on the ground floor. The forum is a narrow, U-shaped space, surrounding an event hall.
6. The ground floor and the first floor (event rooms and library), including terrace access, are step-free and accessible for wheelchair users.
7. Access to the terrace on the 1st floor must be registered at the reception desk in the forum.
8. All floors are accessible via an elevator.
9. In the event hall on the ground floor, a barrier-free podium is available if required.

### Accessibility by bus and train

According to the BVG, all buses are equipped with fold-out ramps and are barrier-free accessible.

Since September 24, 2024 the station U Märkisches Museum has been affected by an elevator malfunction until further notice. The station U Kottbusser Tor has a lift from the U1 and U3 tracks to street level as well as the BVG Muva on-demand service. The stations U Strausberger Platz, U Weberwiese and S+U Warschauer Straße also have lifts and the BVG Muva on-demand service.

**BVG Muva offers an elevator replacement** along the subway lines (completely on the U4 and U8) as well as on parts of the S-Bahn lines S1, S2, S3, S5, S7, S8, S9, S25, S26, S41, S42, S75 and S85. The elevator replacement runs (in both directions) – as needed and without a timetable. ### Accessibility at Rosa-Luxemburg-Stiftung

The area in front of the main entrance has been paved with a tarred access path. The Access is therefore wheelchair-accessible and barrier-free. Efficient drainage of rainwater ensures that the paths can be used in all weather conditions. (Both) the building and the forum (exhibition area) are structurally barrier-free and allow wheelchair users and people with walking aids unrestricted access.

### Toilets

There is a wheelchair-accessible/barrier-free toilet with an automatic door opening located at the ground floor (on the left side, next to the reception desk). This toilet contains a changing table, which is not barrier-free. There is a grab bar in each of the unisex toilets on the ground floor. Free hygiene products (tampons/pads) are available in all public toilets.

### Art audio guide

An audio guide is available to help you navigate through the exhibition. Therefore you will need to bring your smartphone and headphones. Alternatively, an MP3 player is provided for free and can be borrowed from the reception desk.
